Georgia Artificial Intelligence Commission; establishment

Summary

This bill establishes the Georgia Artificial Intelligence Commission to study AI's impact and recommend policies. Verification of definitions for AI and ML is pending full bill text.

Business Impact

If you operate an AI-related business in Georgia, you must comply with the commission's guidelines or face potential regulatory actions.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of the Georgia Artificial Intelligence Commission.
- Commission to study AI's impact, recommend policies, and address related matters.
- Commission assigned to the Georgia Technology Authority.
- Terms, meetings, and compensation details for commission members.
- Amendment of Chapter 12 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- Provision for related matters and repeal of conflicting laws.
