Summary

HB0320 amends AI policy in Utah, establishing an Office of Artificial Intelligence to oversee AI initiatives and ensure ethical standards.

Business Impact

If you operate in Utah and use AI, you must comply with new regulatory standards by January 1, 2025, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes an Office of Artificial Intelligence.
- Mandates oversight of AI initiatives.
- Ensures compliance with ethical standards.
- Requires public engagement and transparency.
