Adds to existing law to establish provisions regarding unbiased artificial intelligence in state government purchasing.

## Summary

House Bill 687 proposes provisions for unbiased AI in Idaho state government purchasing, but any assumptions about standards and enforcement are speculative without the full text.

## Business Impact

If you engage in state government purchasing involving AI, you must ensure compliance with unbiased AI provisions or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Proposes provisions for unbiased AI in state purchasing based on title and description.
- Details on standards, enforcement mechanisms, and impacts require full bill text.
- The definition and measurement of 'unbiased AI' are not addressed without the full text.

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI systems used in state purchasing are unbiased | Who: Vendors and contractors | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance may apply
