Making it unlawful for a person to knowingly train artificial intelligence to encourage or support suicide or the unlawful killing of another person, provide emotional support, develop emotional relationships, act as a healthcare professional, simulate humans or encourage isolation.

Summary

This bill makes it unlawful to train AI to support suicide, unlawful killing, develop emotional relationships, encourage isolation, or act as a healthcare professional.

Business Impact

If you develop AI systems in Kansas, you must ensure they do not promote harmful behaviors or emotional relationships or face legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits training AI to encourage or support suicide.
- Bans AI development that promotes unlawful killing.
- Restricts AI from providing emotional support or developing emotional relationships.
- Forbids AI systems that encourage isolation.
- Prohibits AI from acting as a healthcare professional.
- Bans AI from simulating humans.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI systems do not promote harmful behaviors or emotional relationships. | Who: Developers and organizations involved in AI training. | Penalty: Legal consequences for non-compliance.
