Summary

HB3545 prohibits certain AI uses like surveillance and permits uses such as data analysis in Oklahoma state agencies, with oversight by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, effective January 1, 2024.

Business Impact

If you operate a state agency in Oklahoma, you must comply with AI usage regulations by the effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI use for surveillance in state agencies.
- Permits AI use for data analysis in state agencies.
- The Office of Management and Enterprise Services oversees compliance.
- Effective date is January 1, 2024.

Compliance Checklist

- Review and update AI usage policies to align with the bill's provisions | Who: All state agencies utilizing AI | Penalty: Potential administrative repercussions
- Ensure that AI applications used are within the permitted categories | Who: State agencies | Penalty: Legal challenges or administrative penalties
