Summary

This bill mandates informed consent for AI use by licensed mental health professionals and health care providers, detailing specific authorized and prohibited uses, with an emergency designation.

Business Impact

If you use AI in mental health services in Oklahoma, you must obtain informed consent from clients or face potential legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- Mandates informed consent for AI use by licensed mental health professionals and health care providers, specifying what constitutes informed consent.
- Details authorized and prohibited uses of AI.
- Emergency designation for immediate enactment upon passage, ensuring rapid implementation.

Compliance Checklist

- Obtain informed consent from clients before using AI tools. | Who: Licensed mental health professionals and healthcare providers. | Penalty: Potential legal consequences for non-compliance.
