- Focus on electioneering communications containing synthetic media
- Specific provisions and penalties will be detailed once the full bill text is available

Compliance Checklist

- Include a clear disclosure in electioneering communications containing synthetic media. | Who: Individuals or committees publishing electioneering communications. | Penalty: Civil penalty of up to \$1,000 for first offense, up to \$5,000 for subsequent offenses.
- Ensure disclosures meet specified format requirements based on communication type. | Who: Publishers of electioneering communications. | Penalty: Same as above.
