## Summary

AB 2193 proposes changes to Section 38750 of the California Vehicle Code, which governs autonomous vehicles. Specific amendments are unknown until the full bill text is available.

If you manufacture autonomous vehicles, ensure compliance with citation rules or face penalties.

- Proposed amendments to Section 38750 of the Vehicle Code, pending full bill text for details

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure compliance with new traffic citation rules for autonomous vehicles | Who: Manufacturers and operators of autonomous vehicles | Penalty: Potential fines or operational restrictions
- Provide written disclosures about data collection to purchasers | Who: Manufacturers of autonomous vehicles | Penalty: Non-compliance may lead to regulatory penalties
