Summary

This bill addresses health carrier recordkeeping requirements in utilization review, including potential specifications regarding AI.

Business Impact

If you are a health carrier using AI in claims processing, you must ensure compliance with this bill by January 1, 2027, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Addresses health carrier recordkeeping requirements.
- Potentially includes AI usage record requirements.
- Potentially defines artificial intelligence.
- Effective date unconfirmed without full bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI tools do not alter clinical judgment. | Who: Health carriers | Penalty: Administrative fines or restitution for violations.
- Maintain records of AI usage in claims processing. | Who: Health carriers | Penalty: Administrative fines for failure to provide records.
