Summary

This bill proposes a framework for requesting exceptions to AI usage restrictions, pending approval from the commissioner of the department of information technology.

Business Impact

If your state agency uses AI, you must submit an exception request to the executive council to continue operations legally.

Key Provisions

- Outlines a process for requesting exceptions to AI usage restrictions.
- Requires approval from the commissioner of the department of information technology.

Compliance Checklist

- Submit an exception request for AI use. | Who: Commissioners or heads of state agencies. | Penalty: Potential inability to use AI legally without an approved exception.
