Summary

The Conversational AI Safety Act's intent and provisions cannot be confirmed due to the absence of the full bill text.

Business Impact

If you use AI for customer interactions in Idaho, you must comply with the Conversational AI Safety Act by the effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- The bill's intent to regulate conversational AI systems cannot be confirmed without the full bill text.
- Enforcement mechanisms and penalties cannot be verified without the bill text.
