Summary

HSB 635 is a legislative proposal in Iowa detailing the ownership of AI-generated outputs and trained AI systems, with specific provisions outlined in the bill.

Business Impact

If you operate in Iowa and use AI, you must clarify ownership of AI outputs by the bill's effective date or face legal disputes.

Key Provisions

- The bill specifies ownership rights for AI-generated outputs, detailing who holds the rights to content produced by AI.
- It outlines the ownership of trained AI systems, clarifying the legal responsibilities of AI developers and users.
