A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-31 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to prohibiting deepfake videos and images; and to provide a penalty.

Summary

This bill aims to prohibit the creation and distribution of deepfake videos and images, specifying penalties for violations.

Business Impact

If you create or distribute digital content in North Dakota, you must ensure it does not include deepfakes or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the creation of deepfake videos and images.
- Prohibits the distribution of deepfake videos and images.
- Specifies penalties for violations.
- Includes exceptions for parody or satire.
