SCH CD-TEACHER EVALUATION-AI

Last Action (May 27, 2026): Passed Both Houses

Summary

This bill prohibits the use of AI tools for scoring teacher evaluations while allowing their use for administrative support.

Business Impact

If you use AI for scoring teacher evaluations, you must cease this practice by the bill's enactment date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI tools from being used to assign scores or ratings in teacher evaluations.
- Allows AI tools to assist in administrative tasks related to evaluations.
- Emphasizes the necessity of professional judgment in teacher evaluations.

Compliance Checklist
