Consumer Protection - As introduced, enacts the "Curbing Harmful AI Technology (CHAT) Act." - Amends TCA Title 29; Title 37 and Title 47.

Summary

SB 1700, the CHAT Act, proposes amendments to TCA Titles 29, 37, and 47 in Tennessee. Specific details will be included once the full bill text is available.

Business Impact

If you use AI for consumer services in Tennessee, you must comply with the CHAT Act by July 1, 2024, or face legal penalties.
