### Summary

SB 2010 may address AI use by health insurers in Rhode Island; details await full bill text. The bill is under legislative review.

### Business Impact

If you use AI for health insurance claims, expect new transparency requirements.

### Key Provisions

- Potential requirement for health insurers to disclose AI use in claims management, pending confirmation.
- Specific requirements and definitions related to AI use are speculative until verified.
- Penalties and enforcement measures for non-compliance are speculative until confirmed.
