Relating to: prohibiting state agencies and local governmental units from using facial recognition technology or data generated from it.

Risk: Low

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Mar 23, 2026): Failed to pass pursuant to Senate Joint Resolution 1

Summary

AB 575 prohibits Wisconsin state agencies and local governmental units from using facial recognition technology. Full bill text is needed to verify specifics.

Business Impact

If you operate a state agency or local government in Wisconsin, you must cease using facial recognition technology by the bill's enactment date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits state agencies from using facial recognition technology or data.
- Prohibits local governmental units from using facial recognition technology or data.
- Verification of exceptions, penalties, and specific definitions awaits the full bill text.
