Summary

NY A01342: Requires operators of certain generative or surveillance AI systems to collect and transmit oaths of responsible use from users to the attorney general. The types of AI systems covered are not detailed in the available information.

Business Impact

If you operate generative or surveillance AI systems in New York, you must collect user oaths of responsible use or face potential legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- Operators must collect oaths of responsible use from users of certain AI systems.
- Oaths must be transmitted to the attorney general.
- Applies to certain generative and surveillance AI systems, but the types of AI systems covered are not detailed in the available information.
- Penalties or enforcement mechanisms are unknown without the full bill text.
- Potential additional requirements for operators are not detailed without the full bill text. This analysis is based on limited information and may not capture all aspects of the bill.
