Summary

The bill enacts the 'New York artificial intelligence consumer protection act' to prevent AI algorithms from discriminating, based on the official description.

Business Impact

If you deploy high-risk AI in NY, you must conduct audits by 2027 or face legal scrutiny.

Key Provisions

- Assumes documentation of AI systems to ensure transparency.
- Assumes oversight authority to monitor compliance.

- Conduct bias and governance audits for high-risk AI systems. | Who: Developers of high-risk AI systems. | Penalty: Legal action by the attorney general.
- Provide documentation on AI system uses and risks to deployers. | Who: Developers of high-risk AI systems. | Penalty: Legal action by the attorney general.
