Summary

HF4521 authorizes autonomous vehicle operations in Minnesota, detailing a framework for on-demand networks and specifying rulemaking guidelines by the Department of Transportation.

Business Impact

If you operate an autonomous vehicle network in Minnesota, you must comply with new operational rules or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- The bill authorizes the operation of autonomous vehicles in Minnesota.
- It establishes a framework for on-demand autonomous vehicle networks, including safety and insurance requirements.
- The Minnesota Department of Transportation is authorized to conduct rulemaking with specific guidelines.
