## Summary

AB-33 seeks to add Sections 38760, 38761, and 38762 to the California Vehicle Code regarding autonomous vehicles.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles, monitor AB-33 for potential new regulations.

## Key Provisions

- Adds Section 38760 to the Vehicle Code, addressing operational requirements for autonomous vehicles.
- Adds Section 38761 to the Vehicle Code, outlining safety standards.
- Adds Section 38762 to the Vehicle Code, specifying reporting obligations for manufacturers.

- Ensure all autonomous vehicles meet new safety standards. | Who: Manufacturers and operators of autonomous vehicles. | Penalty: Penalties for non-compliance will apply.
- Implement operational protocols as outlined in the new sections. | Who: Operators of autonomous vehicles. | Penalty: Penalties for non-compliance will apply.
