Summary

This bill appropriates funds to various departments, including the attorney general, to enhance the use of uncrewed aircraft systems and autonomous technologies in North Dakota.

Business Impact

If you operate in transportation or agriculture in North Dakota, you must explore the use of uncrewed aircraft systems or face potential funding loss.

Key Provisions

- Appropriates funds to enhance the use of uncrewed aircraft systems.
- Supports the integration of autonomous vehicles in state operations.
- Mandates a legislative management study on the use of these technologies.
- Requires a report to be submitted to the legislative management.
- Involves multiple state departments including agriculture, transportation, the attorney general, career and technical education, and health and human services.
