Automatic Reserve Component Enrollment Act of 2009

Last Action (Oct 19, 2009): Read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs.

Summary

The bill mandates automatic enrollment of discharged National Guard and reserve members in VA health programs, ensuring privacy and outreach.

Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles, you must comply with new standards by 2025 or face regulatory penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes federal standards for autonomous vehicle operation, though specifics are not detailed.
