This resolution establishes a permit requirement for testing autonomous vehicles in the District of Columbia.

If you operate autonomous vehicles in D.C., you must obtain a testing permit or face penalties.

- Mandates safety assessments prior to permit approval.
- Outlines the application process for obtaining a testing permit.
