Summary

This bill aims to amend existing laws and establish new regulations governing the use of artificial intelligence by health insurers in Ohio.

Business Impact

If you are a health insurer in Ohio using AI, you must comply with new regulations or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Amends section 3902.50 of the Revised Code.
- Enacts section 3902.80 to establish new regulations.
- Regulates the use of AI by health insurers.
