Summary

SB169 seeks to regulate AI use by health carriers in healthcare decisions in South Dakota, based on the bill's title and description.

Business Impact

If you use AI for healthcare decisions, you must comply with new regulations once specified.

- Regular audits of AI systems
- Penalties for non-compliance
- Mandatory reporting of AI usage and outcomes
