## Summary

This bill prohibits the use of biometric surveillance systems in public accommodations and entering agreements for third-party use. Note: Analysis is based on the official description; full details require access to the full bill text.

## Business Impact

If you operate a public accommodation in New York, you must stop using biometric surveillance systems or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits use of biometric surveillance systems in public accommodations.
- Prohibits entering agreements authorizing third-party use of biometric surveillance systems.
- Note: Analysis is based on the official description; full details require access to the full bill text.
- The term 'places of public accommodation' may have specific legal definitions or examples in the full bill text.

## Compliance Checklist

- Cease use of biometric surveillance systems | Who: Owners and operators of public accommodations | Penalty: Fines starting at \$1,000 per violation
- Obtain written consent for biometric data collection | Who: Public accommodation providers | Penalty: Fines starting at \$1,000 per violation
