## Summary

The AI Accountability Act directs a study and public meetings on artificial intelligence systems by the Assistant Secretary of Commerce, with specific objectives outlined.

## Business Impact

If you develop or use AI systems, you must participate in public meetings and provide input by an unspecified date or face potential scrutiny.

## Key Provisions

- Directs a study on artificial intelligence systems with specific objectives.
- Mandates public meetings for stakeholder engagement.
- Involves the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information.
