Summary

NY A 10379 prohibits AI companions, including but not limited to chatbots, from using features deemed unsafe for minors. The bill defines terms related to AI companions and unsafe features.

Business Impact

If you use AI chatbots, you must ensure features are safe for minors or face regulatory action.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI companions, including chatbots, from using features deemed unsafe for minors.
- The bill defines terms related to AI companions and unsafe features.
- Without the full bill text, it is unclear if specifics on the responsible agency for rule-making and enforcement are included.
- The bill text needs to be checked for any specified penalties or fines for violations.
