## Ai, Deepfakes, Cybersecurity, Data Xfers

## Summary

The bill's text is unreadable, preventing verification of claims about deepfake disclosure and cybersecurity issues.

## Business Impact

If you use AI in campaign communications in Alaska, you must disclose deepfakes or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Claims of deepfake disclosure requirements cannot be verified.
- Cybersecurity measures are unconfirmed.
- Data privacy regulations are unverified.
- Penalties for non-compliance are not confirmed.
- Transparency in AI usage is unverified.

## Compliance Checklist

- Disclose any use of deepfakes in campaign communications | Who: Campaign operators using AI technologies | Penalty: Potential fines for non-compliance
- Implement cybersecurity measures as required by the bill | Who: Businesses involved in campaign activities | Penalty: Potential penalties for failing to comply with cybersecurity regulations
