AZ HB2410: Artificial intelligence; privileged communications claims cannot be verified without full bill text.

Business Impact

If you communicate with AI for professional advice, ensure those communications are treated as privileged to avoid legal issues.

Key Provisions

- Claims about privileged communications with AI cannot be verified without the bill text.
- Potential amendments to the Arizona Revised Statutes are unconfirmed without the bill text.
- Introduction of any new chapters focused on AI cannot be verified without the bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure communications with AI are treated as privileged. | Who: Businesses and professionals using AI for advice. | Penalty: Loss of privilege in legal contexts.
