Artificial intelligence; sexual abuse materials

Introduced

Risk: High

Comprehensive

Last Action (Jan 23, 2024): House read second time

Summary

This bill prohibits the use of AI systems to create or store child sexual abuse material and establishes penalties for violations.

Business Impact

If you operate AI systems, you must ensure they do not create or store child sexual abuse material or face penalties up to \$500,000.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI systems from creating or using child sexual abuse material.
- Attorney General is the sole enforcer of this prohibition.
- Civil penalties can reach up to \$500,000 for violations.
- Defines 'child sexual abuse material' clearly.
- Allows for restitution recovery for affected individuals.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI systems do not create or store child sexual abuse material. | Who: Any person or entity using AI systems. | Penalty: Up to \$500,000 for violations.
