Summary

This bill regulates AI devices in health care. Definitions for 'qualified end-user' and 'deployer', as well as a quality assurance program, need verification. Effective date included.

Business Impact

If you deploy AI devices in health care in Oklahoma, you must comply with quality assurance standards by the effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Regulates AI devices in health care.
- Verification needed for definitions of 'qualified end-user' and 'deployer'.
- Verification needed for a mandated quality assurance program.
- Includes an effective date.

Compliance Checklist

- Implement a quality assurance program for AI devices. | Who: Health care providers and AI technology deployers. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance may apply.
