## Summary

SB1293 relates to the establishment of a subaccount for funding predictive policing technology under GIITEM.

## Business Impact

If you develop or use predictive policing technology in Arizona, you must comply with funding regulations or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Establishment of a GIITEM subaccount for predictive policing technology funding.
- Allocation of resources for law enforcement agencies utilizing predictive analytics.
