Requires the owner, licensee or operator of a generative artificial intelligence system to conspicuously display a notice on the system's user interface that is reasonably calculated to consistently apprise the user that the outputs of the generative artificial intelligence system may be inaccurate.

Summary

This bill mandates that generative AI systems display a notice informing users that outputs may be inaccurate.

Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system, you must display a notice about potential inaccuracies within 90 days or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Generative AI systems must display a notice about potential inaccuracies in outputs.
- The notice must be clear and conspicuous on the user interface.

Compliance Checklist

- Display a notice about output inaccuracies on the user interface | Who: Owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems | Penalty: Up to \$1,000 for each violation
