- Requires risk management policies for AI-controlled critical infrastructure (Chapter 35, Title 1)

- Develop and implement risk management policies for AI systems. | Who: Entities controlling critical infrastructure using AI. | Penalty: Potential regulatory penalties for non-compliance.
- Assess conditions under which computational resources may be restricted. | Who: Businesses utilizing private computational resources. | Penalty: Restrictions may apply if conditions are not met.
