HF 4979 prohibits AI from delivering professional services directly to consumers in Minnesota, with enforcement and penalties provided. Full details require the complete text.

Business Impact

If you use AI for professional services, you must cease direct consumer delivery or face unspecified penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits delivery of professional services through AI directly to consumers.
- Includes enforcement and penalties.
- Specific details like definitions and potential exceptions require the full text.
