Report: labor force impact: artificial intelligence.

## Summary

CA AB 2545 establishes a project to assess AI's labor force impact, requiring a report by 2028, and dissolves the advisory panel upon submission.

## Business Impact

If you employ workers in California, you must prepare for potential policy changes regarding AI's impact on labor by January 1, 2028.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes the California AI Worker Impact Data Assessment Project.
- Creates an advisory panel of 13 members to assess AI's impact on the labor force.
- Requires a report with policy recommendations to be submitted by January 1, 2028.
- Dissolves the advisory panel upon report submission.
- Repeals provisions on January 1, 2029.
