AI COMPANION MODEL SAFETY ACT

Summary

IL SB 3384: AI COMPANION MODEL SAFETY ACT ensures AI models detect suicidal ideation, require clear user notifications, and amends the State Finance Act. Effective January 1, 2027.

Business Impact

If you operate AI companions in Illinois, you must implement safety protocols by January 1, 2027, or face civil penalties.

Key Provisions

- Operators must implement protocols to detect and address suicidal ideation in users.
- Operators must notify users that they are interacting with an AI, either verbally or in text, in a clear and conspicuous manner.
- Civil penalties will be imposed for non-compliance.
- All collected penalties will go to the Statewide 9-8-8 Trust Fund.
- The bill amends the State Finance Act to make a conforming change.
- The bill is effective January 1, 2027.
