Consumer Protection - As introduced, enacts the "Curbing Harmful AI Technology (CHAT) Act." - Amends TCA Title 29; Title 37 and Title 47.

## Summary

The CHAT Act is introduced to potentially regulate AI technology for consumer protection, but specific details require the full bill text for confirmation.

## Business Impact

If you develop or use AI technologies in Tennessee, you must comply with new consumer protection regulations or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Potential amendments to TCA Title 29, Title 37, and Title 47 related to AI regulations require confirmation from the full text.
- Specific oversight mechanisms and penalties are to be confirmed upon full text review.
