## SCH CD-AI USE IN EDUC COMM

## Summary

IL HB 5113: Establishes the 'Artificial-Intelligence Use in Education Commission' by the State Board of Education to study AI and smartphone use, effective January 1, 2027, repeals on January 1, 2030.

## Business Impact

If you operate a school in Illinois, you must comply with AI use recommendations by January 1, 2027, or risk non-compliance issues.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes the 'Artificial-Intelligence Use in Education Commission' by the State Board of Education.
- Commission to recommend best practices for AI and smartphone use in schools.
- Commission to compile research on effective educational practices and collaborate on recommendations for student-learning outcomes.
- Membership includes educators, policymakers, technology experts, and representatives from parents' associations, with quarterly meetings, reporting, and support requirements outlined.
- Repeals provisions on January 1, 2030.
- Effective date for the commission is January 1, 2027.
