Summary

IL SB 3444: AI MODEL SAFETY requires developers to avoid intentional or reckless harm for liability protection and mandates safety protocols. It is currently in committee.

Business Impact

If you develop frontier AI models in Illinois, you must publish safety protocols and transparency reports to limit liability.

Key Provisions

- Developers must not intentionally or recklessly cause critical harms to qualify for liability protection.
- Developers must publish a safety and security protocol and a transparency report.
- Compliance can be achieved by adhering to EU safety requirements or federal agreements.
- The Act ceases to apply if federal laws establish overlapping requirements.
