## NO AI IN HEALTH CARE PRICING

Last Action (May 22, 2026): Rule 3-9(a) / Re-referred to Assignments

### Summary

SB 3027 prohibits hospitals in Illinois from using artificial intelligence, as defined by the Illinois Human Rights Act, to set or influence health care pricing or billing.

### Business Impact

If you operate a hospital in Illinois, you must stop using AI for pricing or billing immediately to avoid penalties.

### Key Provisions

- Prohibits hospitals from using AI to set health care pricing.
- Defines 'artificial intelligence' as per the Illinois Human Rights Act.
- Amends the Fair Patient Billing Act.
