Summary

This bill mandates certification for appellant briefs produced with generative AI, requiring human review and disclosure.

Business Impact

If you draft legal briefs using generative AI in New York, you must disclose AI use and certify human review to avoid potential legal issues.

- Requires disclosure of generative AI use in appellant briefs.
- Mandates certification of human review of AI-generated content.
