## Summary

This bill mandates the State Bar of California to disclose the use of AI-generated content in its examination materials and processes, effective January 1, 2028.

## Business Impact

If you develop or administer bar examination materials in California, you must disclose AI-generated content by January 1, 2028.

## Key Provisions

- Requires the State Bar to disclose AI-generated content on its website, effective January 1, 2028.
- Mandates disclosure on the cover page of examination study materials, effective January 1, 2028.
- Applies to all AI-generated content regardless of human review, effective January 1, 2028.
