## Summary

AB302 allows elected officials and judges to request deletion of their personal information from data brokers.

## Business Impact

If you use AI for decisions in housing or employment, ensure compliance with inventory requirements by September 1, 2024.

## Key Provisions

- Elected officials and judges can request data brokers to delete their personal information.
- Data brokers are required to comply with deletion requests from elected officials and judges.
