Summary

AB2013 mandates developers of generative AI systems to disclose training data details on their websites by January 1, 2026.

Business Impact

If you develop generative AI systems, disclose training data details by January 1, 2026, or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- 3111: Developers must disclose training data details on their websites.
- 3111(a): Documentation must include a summary of datasets used.
- 3111(b): Exceptions for security, aircraft, and defense systems.
