Requires publishers of books created wholly or partially with the use of generative artificial intelligence to disclose such use of generative artificial intelligence before the completion of such sale; applies to all printed and digital books consisting of text, pictures, audio, puzzles, games or...

Summary

This bill mandates that publishers disclose the use of generative AI in books before the completion of the sale, covering all formats and content types.

Business Impact

If you publish books using generative AI, you must disclose this use before sale or face penalties starting January 1, 2025.

Key Provisions

- Books created with generative AI must disclose this before the completion of the sale.
- Applies to all printed and digital books, regardless of content type.

Compliance Checklist

- Include a disclosure on the cover of books created with generative AI | Who: Publishers of books | Penalty: Not specified in the bill
