Summary

AB2811 requires attorneys to certify AI use in court filings, adding Section 6068.1 to the Business and Professions Code.

Business Impact

If you use AI for legal document drafting, you must certify its use in an affidavit for seven years.

Key Provisions

- Section 6068.1: Requires attorneys to maintain an affidavit certifying AI use in court document drafting.
- Defines 'generative artificial intelligence' and outlines affidavit requirements.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI tools used in court filings meet new standards. | Who: Attorneys using AI in California. | Penalty: Potential disciplinary actions by the state bar.
