AB2876 amends Section 33548 of the Education Code to consider AI and media literacy in curriculum frameworks.

Key Provisions

- Amends Section 33548 of the Education Code.
- Requires consideration of media literacy in mathematics, science, and history-social science curriculum frameworks after January 1, 2024.
- Requires consideration of the Model Library Standards in ELA/ELD curriculum framework.
- Requires consideration of AI literacy in mathematics, science, and history-social science curriculum frameworks after January 1, 2025.
